SUPPORT FOR TEACHERS

Teachers in New Tech schools participate in high-quality, on-going professional development provided by New Tech Network through formal events, on-site training, and 1:1 coaching. On average, a New Tech teacher participates in 80 hours of formal professional development during NTN events in the first year of implementation of a New Tech school, and 40 hours in each subsequent year. In addition, NTN school development coaches conduct on-site training and personalized coaching tailored to individual school and teachers needs during regular school site visits.

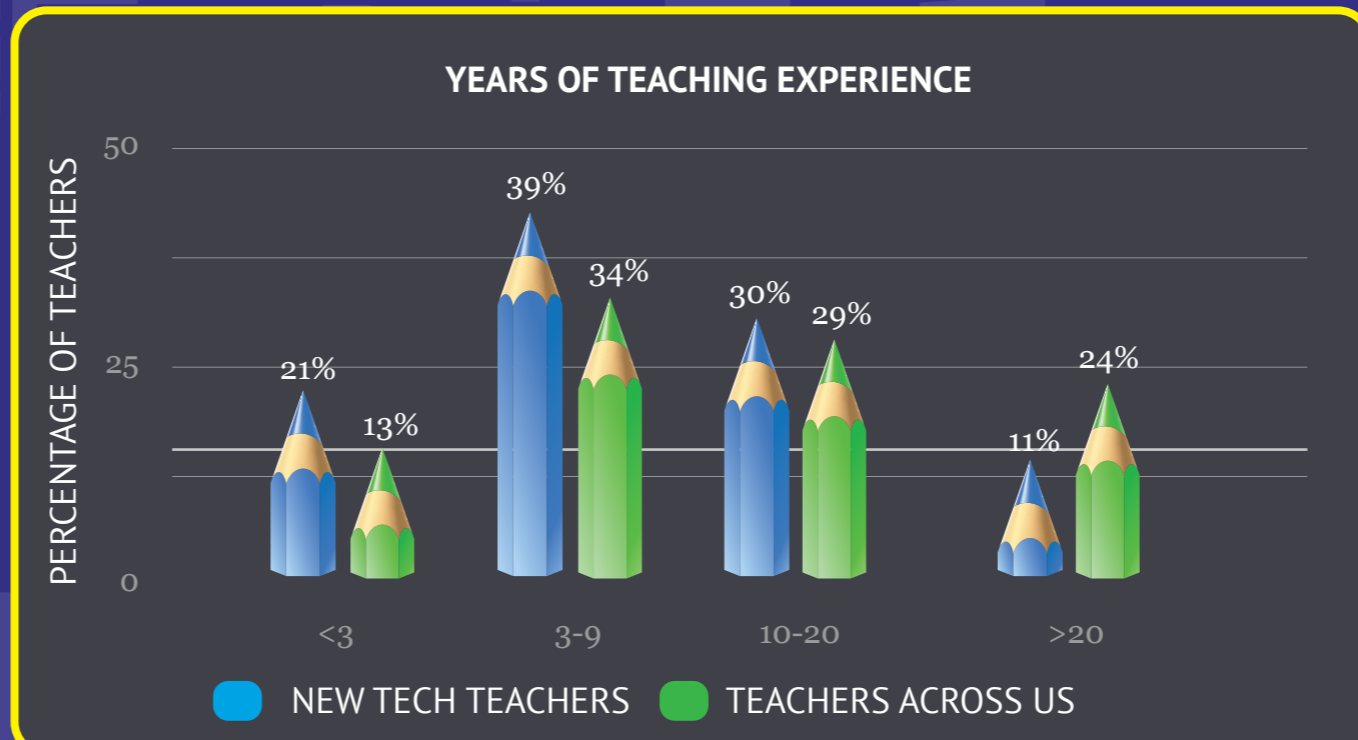
